

STRENGTHS OF THE COLLEGE:

- The college is one of the oldest Co-educational Higher Education (Estb. in 1967) in whole region.
- The College ranked at No. 9th as **"College of Excellence"** in all over Haryana by Department of Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula.
- Being as **"College of Excellence"** the college receives grants under **Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (PM-USHA)** a Central Govt. sponsored scheme to fund states institutions for infrastructural developments with the vision to attain higher levels of access, equity, and excellence in the state higher education system.
- Two technical / Job oriented courses- B.B.A. and B.C.A. got approval from AICTE- All India Council for Technical Education. (Annexure-XXXIII)
- The college has two PG courses: M.Sc. Mathematics and M.Com.
- The college has classes in evening shift also, which caters the educational needs of working people.
- The college has a well-equipped Library with annual N-List subscription upgraded with SOUL 3.0 system software.
- The college has excellence in sports, every year our students won and get several positions in MDU Rohtak and all India Inter University level in different games and sports.
- The college has NCC units for Boys and Girls.
- The college has two NSS units.

WEAKNESS OF THE COLLEGE:

Being the oldest educational institution, the college is suffering from various problems related to infrastructure, requirement of supportive staffs and fund issues, which needs urgent concern from Department and State Govt. as given below:

- The college building is in dilapidated stage, which needs urgent repairing and renovation.
- Sewerage system is blocked and sometimes backflow resulting constant stink.
- Termite at large scale.
- Water supply in the college must be improved.
- Electricity system of the college is in worse condition. There is urgent need to replace wiring and electric switches/boards, etc.
- Besides above, there is a lack of supporting staff and teaching staff.
- More funds/grants should be provided for college all round development.



Following Committee Members visited in Govt. College, Bahadurgarh on 27th May, 2024 for Academic and Administrative Audit:
Observations and Recommendation of committee members:

1. NAAC Accreditation required.
2. Building: Commerce Block- Urgently renovation and extension required.
Arts Block and Science Block: New Building required.
3. Washrooms for students and staff badly required. Renovation/ repairing urgently required.
4. Multipurpose hall.
5. Lab attendants and Supporting staffs required for laboratories.
6. 21 more teaching staff required.
7. New value aided / skill based enhancement courses for implementing NEP.
8. Teaching staff should participate actively in teacher development programmes.
9. For students: under Placement Cell, facilities should be provided for the preparation of Competitive examinations.
10. Regular meeting with Alumni.
11. Library requires a new meeting hall with the capacity of 200 students with furniture.
12. Appointment of legal expert for dealing the legal cases and handling RTIs.
13. Academic refinement required, as the result of the various classes are below from university results.
14. Staff should be well familiar with NEP programmes through active participation in NEP seminars and courses.
15. Water harvesting system requires more maintenance.
16. Attached bathrooms for Girls common room.
17. New drainage system for the college.
18. Department wise computer with printer for all departments.




