WEAKNESS OF THE COLLEGE:

Being the oldest educational institution, the college is suffering from various problems related to infrastructure. requirement of supportive staffs and fund issues, which needs urgent concern from Department and State Govt. as given below:

- The college building is in dilapidated stage, which needs urgent repairing and renovation.
- Sewerage system is blocked and sometimes backflow resulting constant stink.
- Termite at large scale.
- Water supply in the college must be improved.
- Electricity system of the college is in worse condition. There is urgent need to replace wiring and electric switches/boards, etc.
- Besides above, there is a lack of supporting staff and teaching staff.
- More funds/grants should be provided for college all round development.
